### **Items currently sought for the College gardens**

Hardwood benches for the Fellows' Garden would be welcomed. Estimate £200 – 300.

#### *Broussonetia papyrifera*

Paper Mulberry. A deciduous tree growing to 15 m tall. Red fruits 3 - 4 cm diameter are borne in summer. The bark is composed of very strong fibres, and is used for making paper in Japan, Fiji, and other Pacific Islands. To be planted behind the pond. Estimated price is £100 - 200, depending on size; this includes stake and ties. The College's signmaker quoted £117.50 for metal plaques. Plastic plaques are not satisfactory.
