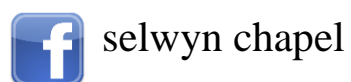

THE CHAPEL

The Chapel provides a sacred space at the heart of the College for all members of **Selwyn College** and **Newnham College** to use as a place of prayer and reflection. The Chapel is open to all from early in the morning until late at night, and unless a service is taking place, silence is kept between 12:00 noon and 1:00pm each day during Full Term. In addition to Sunday services, daily prayers are offered morning and evening on weekdays. Requests for prayer can be written on the intercessions board in the ante-chapel.

The Dean of Chapel & Chaplain, Hugh Shilson-Thomas, is a priest in the Church of England. He is available to all members of College in confidence to lend a listening ear, provide support or engage with those exploring questions of faith. He can put members of faiths other than Christianity in touch with their own faith communities. He is also part-time Chaplain at Newnham College.

The Assistant Chaplain, Roger Revell, is also an Anglican priest and a Selwyn graduate student.

The **Gosden and Frost Scholars** and **Ordinand on Attachment** are students training for ordained ministry in the Church of England. They undertake duties in and around the Chapel. Others, detailed below, are among those who support the ministry of the Chapel in a variety of ways.

SPECIAL SERVICES THIS TERM

The **FRESHERS' SERVICE** takes place at 5:30pm on Sunday 6 October (preacher: the Dean of Chapel). Followed by a (free) Freshers' Supper for new undergraduates at 6:30pm (New SCR).

CHORAL COMPLINE by candlelight will be sung by the Choir on 16 Oct and 20 Nov at 9:30pm.

This term's Choral Eucharist will take place on Sunday 3 November at 6pm, the feast of **ALL SAINTS**.

On **REMEMBRANCE SUNDAY**, 10 November, Holy Communion will be celebrated at 10:00am finishing in time to keep the traditional two minutes silence. Later, at 6:00pm, there will be a service of music and readings for remembrance, during which the names of those college members inscribed on the chapel war memorials will be read aloud. The two minute silence will also be kept at 11:00am in Old Court on Armistice Day, 11 November.

At Choral Evensong on Sunday 17 November at 6:00pm we will be joined by those celebrating the launch of a new **FEMALE COMPOSERS' LITURGICAL MUSIC ANTHOLOGY**.

The **ADVENT SUNDAY PROCESSION** with carols is on Sunday 1 December at 6:00pm.

COLLEGE CHRISTMAS CAROL SERVICES will take place on Thursday 5 December at 6:45pm, and on Sunday 8 December at 6:00pm.
