## THE CHAPEL

The Chapel provides a sacred space at the heart of the College for all members of **Selwyn College** and **Newnham College** to use as a place of prayer and reflection. The Chapel is open to all from early in the morning until late at night, and unless a service is taking place, silence is kept between 12:00noon and 1:00pm each day during Full Term. In addition to Sunday services, daily prayers are offered morning and evening on weekdays. Requests for prayer can be written on the intercessions board in the ante-chapel.

**The Dean of Chapel and Chaplain**, Hugh Shilson-Thomas, is a priest in the Church of England. He is available to all members of College in confidence to lend a listening ear, provide support and engage with those exploring questions of faith. He is part-time Chaplain at Newnham College, and can put members of faiths other than Christianity in touch with their own faith communities.

**The Assistant Chaplain**, Hannah Hupfield, is also an Anglican priest as well as being a Selwyn graduate student. The **ordinands on attachment** are also students, mostly at Selwyn, training for ordained ministry in the Church of England. They undertake duties in and around the Chapel.
