Selwyn Chapel provides a sacred space of peace and sanctuary for all members of Selwyn and Newnham colleges (staff, students and Fellows). The Chapel sits at the heart of Selwyn College, and is open from very early in the morning until late at night. An hour's total silence is kept in Chapel between 12 noon and 1pm each day during Full Term. At daily and weekly services, the Dean and Chaplain is joined by others to hold the needs and concerns of the whole community before God. On **REMEMBRANCE SUNDAY**, 13 November, at 6pm, there will be a service of music and readings during which the names of those college members inscribed on the chapel war memorials will be read aloud. On **ARMISTICE DAY**, 11 November, a two minutes' silence will be kept in Old Court.

The **ADVENT SUNDAY PROCESSION** with carols is on Sunday 27 November at 6pm.

COLLEGE CHRISTMAS CAROL SERVICES will take place on Thursday 1 December at 6.45pm and Sunday 4 December at 6:00pm. There will be an additional carol service for alumni and friends on Tuesday 6 December at 7pm, and an ALUMNI CAROL SERVICE at 7pm on Thursday 8 December at St James', Piccadilly, London.
