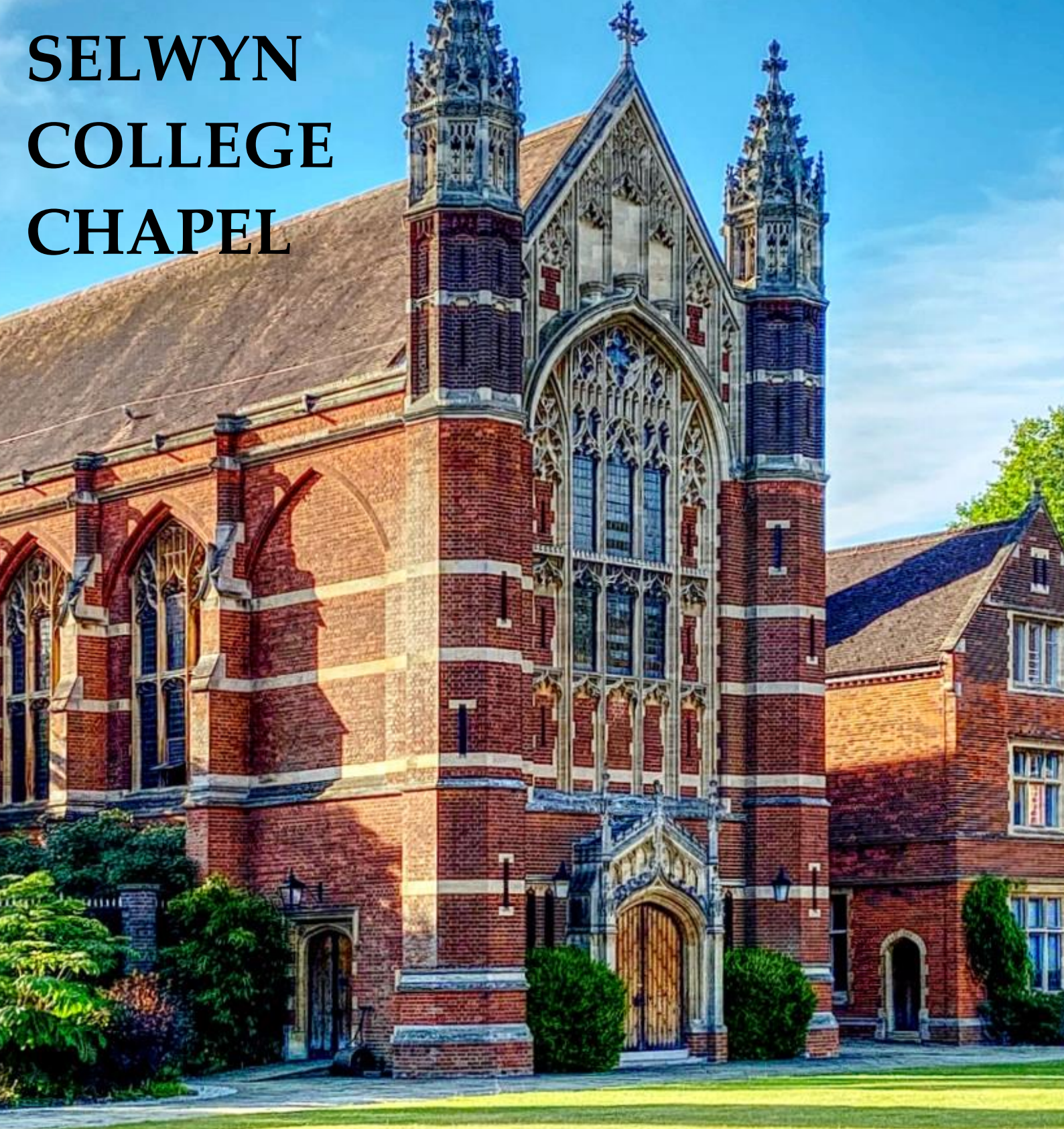


SELWYN COLLEGE CHAPEL

THE CHAPEL

Selwyn Chapel provides a sacred space of peace and sanctuary for all members of Selwyn and Newnham colleges (staff, students and Fellows). The Chapel sits at the heart of Selwyn College, and is open from very early in the morning until late at night. An hour's total silence is kept in Chapel between 12 noon and 1pm each day during Full Term. SPECIAL SERVICES

COMPLINE BY CANDLELIGHT will be sung by the Choir on 12 Oct and 23 Nov at 9.30pm.

All members of Selwyn and Newnham are warmly invited to the Dean and Chaplain's **LICENSING SERVICE** at Great St Mary's on Tuesday 18th October. More details to come.

A **CHORAL EUCHARIST** for the Feast of **ALL SAINTS** will take place on Sunday 30th October at 6pm. The Choir will sing the **DURUFLE REQUIEM** at 9pm on the Eve of All Souls, Tuesday 1st November.

On **REMEMBRANCE SUNDAY**, 13 November, at 6pm, there will be a service of music and readings during which the names of those college members inscribed on the chapel war memorials will be read aloud. On **ARMISTICE DAY**, 11 November, a two minutes' silence will be kept in Old Court.

The **ADVENT SUNDAY PROCESSION** with carols is on Sunday 27 November at 6pm.

COLLEGE CHRISTMAS CAROL SERVICES will take place on Thursday 1 December at 6.45pm and Sunday 4 December at 6:00pm. Details of how to apply for tickets will be made known to all resident members of Selwyn and Newnham. There will be an additional carol service for alumni and friends on Tuesday 6 December at 7pm, and an **ALUMNI CAROL SERVICE** at 7pm on Thursday 8 December at St James', Piccadilly, London.

CHAPEL SUPPER

Sunday evening services are generally the best-attended services of the week, followed by drinks in the Old SCR.
