	Note: Relief Porters are asked to work a variety of shifts and part-shifts to provide support for the Duty Porter during peak times, and to provide cover for sickness absence/annual leave. Flexibility will be required to work a variety of shifts or part-shifts.	
	Casual workers, by their nature, do not work regular hours. The services Relief Porters will provide to the College will be on an ad hoc basis. This means that, while the College will try to give Relief Porter as much notice as possible when offering work, there is no obligation for the College to provide work, nor for any Relief Porter to accept any work that is offered.	
Salary:	£13.64 per hour. An additional enhancement of 20% is paid for all hours worked during a night shift.
