- 1 Let God arise and let his enemies be scat-tered :
let them also that hate him flee be-fore him.
- 2 Like as the smoke vanisheth so shalt thou drive them a-way (---):
and like as wax melteth at the fire so let the ungodly perish at the pre-sence of God.
- 3 But let the righteous be glad and rejoice before God (---):
let them also be mer-ry and joy-ful.
- 4 O sing unto God and sing praises unto his Name (---):
magnify him that rideth upon the heavens as it were upon an horse; *
praise him in his Name JAH and re-joice be-fore him.
- 5 He is a father of the fatherless and defendeth the cause of the wi-dows :
even God in his holy ha-bi-ta-tion.
