- 1 Let God arise and let his enemies be <u>scat</u>-tered: let them also that hate him <u>flee</u> be-fore him.
- Like as the smoke vanisheth so shalt thou drive them a-<u>way</u> (---): and like as wax melteth at the fire so let the ungodly perish at the <u>pre</u>-sence of God.
- But let the righteous be glad and rejoice before <u>God</u> (---): let them also be mer-<u>ry</u> and joy-ful.

  magnify him that rideth upon the heavens as it were upon an horse; \*
  praise him in his Name JAH and re-<u>joice</u> be-fore him.
- He is a father of the fatherless and defendeth the cause of the  $\underline{wi}$ -dows: even God in his holy  $\underline{ha}$ -bi-ta-tion.
- 6 He is the God that maketh men to be of one mind in an <u>house</u>, \* and bringeth the prisoners out of cap-<u>ti</u>-vi^ty: but letteth the runagates conti-<u>nue</u> in scarce-ness.
- O God when thou wentest forth before the <u>peo</u>-ple: when thou wentest <u>through</u> the wil-der^ness;
- The earth shook and the heavens dropped at the presence of <u>God</u> (---): even as Sinai also was moved at the presence of God who is the <u>God</u> of Is-ra^el.
- 9 Thou O God sentest a gracious rain upon thine in-<u>he</u>-ri^tance : and refreshedst it when <u>it</u> was wea-ry.
- 10 Thy congregation shall dwell there-<u>in</u> (---): for thou O God hast of thy goodness pre-<u>pared</u> for the poor.
