- THE KING shall rejoice in thy strength <u>O</u> Lord : exceeding glad shall he be of <u>thy</u> säl-va-tion.
- Thou hast given him his heart's <u>de</u>-sire : and hast not denied him the re-<u>quest</u> öf his lips.
- For thou shalt prevent him with the blessings of good-<u>ness</u>: and shalt set a crown of pure <u>gold</u> üp-on his head.
