RESIDENCE IN THE LONG VACATION 2019 OUTSIDE THE FIXED PERIOD OF RESIDENCE

If you wish to apply to live in College accommodation over part of the long vacation we need to know about your intentions **before the end of the Easter Full Term – Deadline for Return of Long Vacation Form Friday 7 June.**

Applications must be supported by your Tutor, stating the reason for the request. Valid reasons for requesting accommodation for this period include: participation in an official course, undertaking a course of directed reading, working on an academically-related project (e.g. a relevant research or work experience placement). If you are given permission to reside in College you will be allocated an alternative room and charged at the educational rate of £23.00 per day. (Note: Any early return in September will need to be authorised and will be charged at the new 2019/20 rate). Bedding will not be routinely provided but is available on **prior** request to the Head Housekeeper; there is a separate charge for this.

To submit your request to stay over the long vacation, you will need to complete this online form: <u>http://www.sel.cam.ac.uk/long-vacation/</u>. Please note that you will receive a confirmation email once you have submitted this form. If you do not receive this, please contact Mrs Karen Hopper (<u>exeat@sel.cam.ac.uk</u>).

The College cannot normally provide accommodation for those who are simply staying in Cambridge for **non-academically-related work**. There is however occasional availability. Accommodation of this nature (and for those of you who will be graduating on 28 June, accommodation after that date) will be subject to the relevant non-student rates and requests for such bookings should be sent directly to the Accommodation Officer; <u>accommodation@sel.cam.ac.uk</u> who can supply details of charges.
