Anne writes fiction for children and non-fiction for children and adults, much of it on popular science. Her most recent adult book is *The Story of Maps* (Arcturus, 2015); recent children's non-fiction includes *Evolution: Why did fish grow feet?* (Octopus, 2014) and York Notes GCSE: Dr Jekyll and Mr Hyde; her most recent children's fiction is *A Bird in the Hand* (Readzone, 2014). She is Chair of the Society of Authors Educational Writers' Group.



John is author of over a dozen collections of poetry (most recently *To the War Poets*) and several critical studies. This year saw the publication of a major classical music anthology, *Accompanied Voices*, and his OUP edition of Edmund Blunden's *Undertones of War*. Recipient of a Cholmondeley and the Bridport and TLS Prizes, he is one of the judges for the Eric Gregory Award and a regular reviewer for the *Times Literary Supplement*.
